



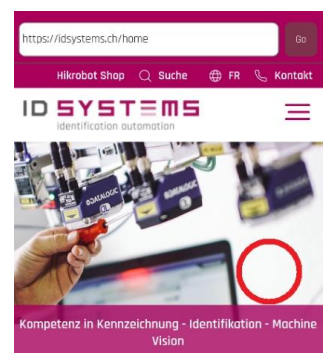
SteelSight for Android

Industrial Enterprise Browser

The modern industrial browser for mobile data collection

1 Introduction

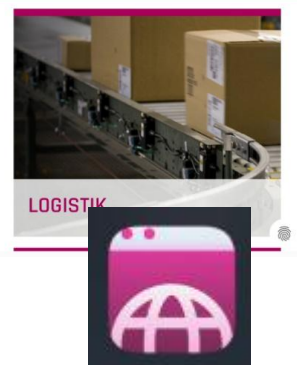
SteelSight by ID-Systems is a specialized enterprise browser application for Android devices. It displays a specified website (e.g. a warehouse management system or a dashboard) in a controlled environment. Targeted restrictions and configuration options ensure that the device is used primarily for its intended business purpose.



2 Installation

The application can be installed in two ways:

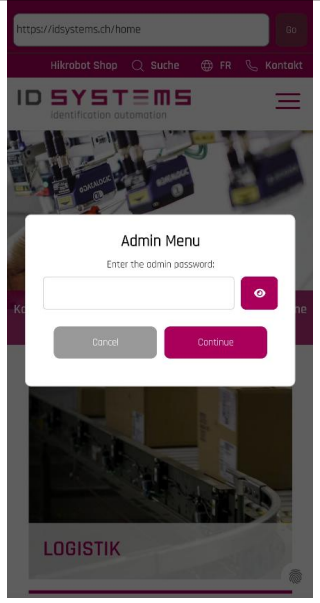
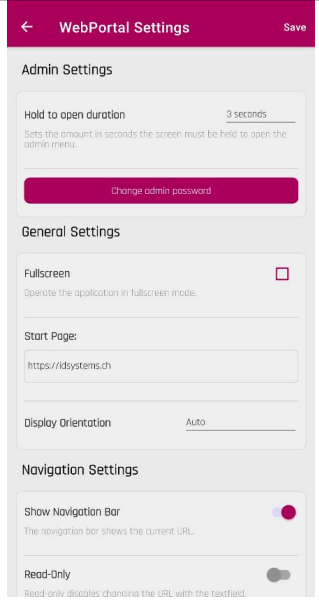
- Preinstalled: On devices purchased directly from ID-Systems AG, SteelSight is usually already installed and preconfigured.
- Manual installation via APK:
 1. Copy the file `ch.idsystems.SteelSight_Signed_vXXXX.apk` to the Android device.
 2. Open the file manager on the device and run the APK file.
 3. Confirm the installation (you may need to allow "Installation from unknown sources" in the Android security settings).
 4. Install the app.



The app appears as SteelSight in your app list.

3 Admin Settings

To open the admin menu, press and hold the background of the displayed webpage (3 seconds by default).

		
Press and hold a spot on the background for a few seconds.	The admin menu is password-protected. The default password is "0000".	The admin menu appears after you enter the password. To save, click "Save".

This section manages access permissions and display options for the configuration.

- **Hold to open duration:** Sets how many seconds you must press and hold the screen to open the admin menu (default: 3 seconds).
- **Change admin password:** Lets you change the password for the protected area.
- **Fullscreen:** Switches the app to full-screen mode to hide the Android status bar.
- **Start Page:** The URL of the webpage loaded automatically when the app starts (e.g. <https://idsystems.ch/> or the link to your warehouse management software or a similar system).
- **Display Orientation:** Sets the screen orientation (Auto, Portrait or Landscape).
- **Show Navigation Bar:** Shows or hides an address bar at the top of the screen.
- **Read-Only:** When enabled, the address bar is read-only. Users can see the URL but cannot manually enter a new address.
- **Setup Blacklist:** Lets you block specific websites or URLs that must not be accessed.
